

Project Brief: Over the course of AirVenture Oshkosh 2015, EAA volunteers will build 5 sets of wings for Rans, Sonex, Van's (RV-12) and Zenith aircraft kits. Those wings will then be given to 5 different EAA chapters to complete the aircraft. Since chapters cannot operate aircraft or own airworthy aircraft, the aircraft must be sold prior to first flight. Ideally, we would like to see the aircraft become the spark to start a local flying club. However, we would entertain another meaningful use of the aircraft. We would like to have the aircraft flown to AirVenture-Oshkosh 2017 for a big celebration and to show them off to the world. All other costs of completing the aircraft, including the remainder of the kit, engine, avionics and paint will be the responsibility of the chapter. You will work directly with the kit manufacturer for acquisition of the remaining kit.

EAA will cover the transportation of the wings to your chapter. However, if you have a way to transport it back to your chapter, we would appreciate it.

EAA will want to run updates on the build project during the construction. In order to do this we would want photos and short updates to share online and in Sport Aviation magazine.

A selection committee made up of EAA volunteers will pick the 5 lucky chapters by June 30th.
